

## OBJECTIVE

The surgical management of cervical cancer remains an essential aspect of subspecialty care, especially in countries with low incidence where case loads and learning opportunities are diminishing. It remains crucial in countries with high incidence and limited access to radiation therapy. The objective of the course is to familiarize young and experienced gynecologic oncologists with the various available types of radical surgeries.

## FORMAT

**The course spans a full week and is dedicated to cervical cancer surgery. It combines morning live surgeries and surgical technique lectures with afternoon video sessions.**

- Face-to-face interaction with the Gemelli Faculty
- Live surgical procedures broadcasted from the Gemelli operating room and anatomy lab
- Moderation and discussions with world-class experts

**This course will also be available online.**

## PROGRAM SYNOPSIS

### Monday November 25

- Surgical anatomy and surgical techniques, definition of radical hysterectomies, nerve sparing, templates for lymph node dissection, sentinel node

### Tuesday November 26

- Morning: Live cadaver surgery broadcasted from the Gemelli anatomy lab
- Afternoon: Tailoring radicality, customizing lymph node assessment, fertility-sparing surgery

### Wednesday November 27

- Morning: Live surgery broadcasted from the Gemelli operating room
- Afternoon: Surgical approaches, state of the art ; specificities of open, laparoscopic, robotic-assisted, vaginal approaches

### Thursday November 28

- Morning: Live surgery broadcasted from the Gemelli operating room
- Afternoon: Surgery for recurrent disease, urinary and vaginal reconstruction

### Friday November 29

- Morning: Live surgery broadcasted from the Gemelli and from the Toulouse Oncopole operating rooms
- Afternoon: Teaching and learning radical hysterectomy in 2024, update on ongoing controlled studies, survey across participants, wrap-up
